WORK EXPERIENCE

YEAR 10 AND YEAR 12

Year 10 and Year 12 have until the end of this half term (24th May) to source a work placement and upload it to the Connect Work Placement App, which is available on Android and IOS.

Work placements are an important aspect of being a UTC student. They will provide students with an insight into the world of work, arriving on time, working as a team, and understanding different roles in an organisation.

It is expected that all students will go out on work placement for two weeks from Monday 8th July - Friday 19th July.

The employers who you work with during this time will summarise a report about each student, as if they were an employee. This may include comments about attitude to work, punctuality, communication and embracing the values of their work place. It is important, therefore, that all students make the right impression. Over previous years, work placements have led to some students being recruited following their studies at the UTC.
