COMBINED CADET FORCE

The cadets took part in a weekend training exercise in April at Altcar Training Camp in Hightown, Formby. They were selected by an independent Army Selection Team.

Kyle Appleton and Sam Woolland will travel to Lithuania later this year to take part in the exchange visit that includes outdoor team building and a range of military themed activities.

The pair will work with other British and foreign cadets, as part of the Exercise Baltic Guard, aimed at engaging the UK and Baltic States.

The selection weekend involved a variety of activities designed to test the leadership skills and character of the cadets. These included command tasks, group discussions, and first aid scenarios.

They will represent UTC Warrington CCF and are amongst other ACF/CCF contingents from all over the UK.
