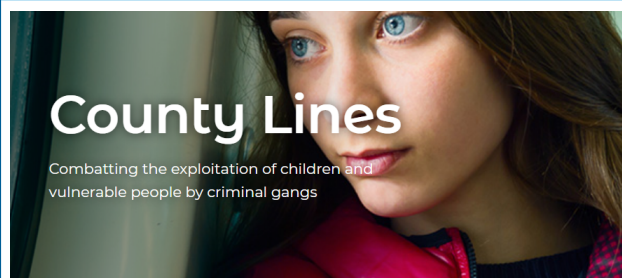

ROYAL NAVY WARSHIP TRIP - 2ND MARCH

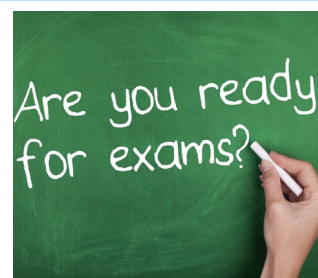
