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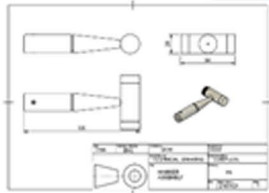
ENGINEERING



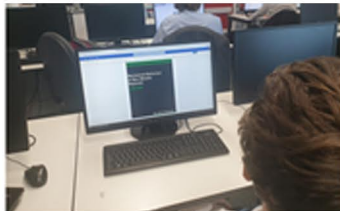
On returning to college, Year 11s have dived straight back into their coursework, where they have to machine different engineering products.

Our own Year 11 students are celebrating their Golden Tickets, as they accepted places into our Sixth Form!



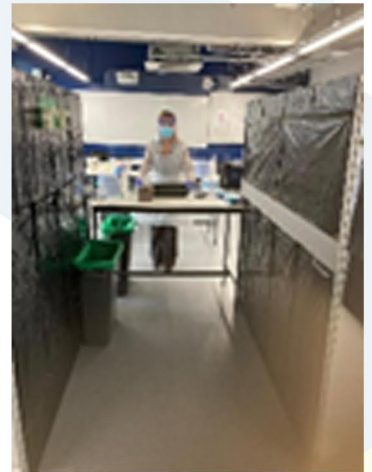
COVID Testing

This week we have been testing all our students. Students will be given home test kits weekly on a Thursday afternoon for the following week and will be asked to sign on collection. Tests are free of charge. Students will receive a pack of three tests in a box with a leaflet on how to take the test and report the results.



Taking the test

We would like students to take their tests before school on a Monday and Thursday. Please make sure you have enough time to do the test before going to college. Preferably this would be in the morning before going into college. However, we understand that for some people this may be challenging. Therefore, tests can be taken the evening before college if needed. You then need to report test results.

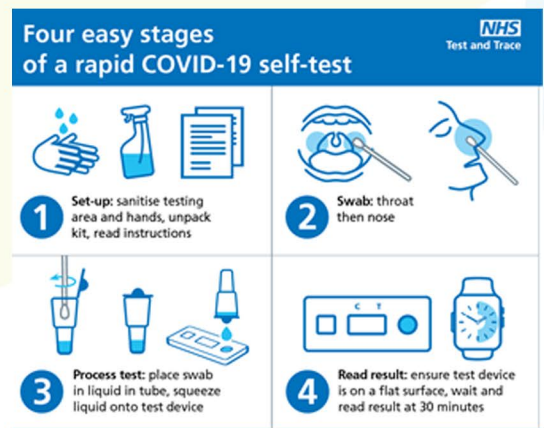

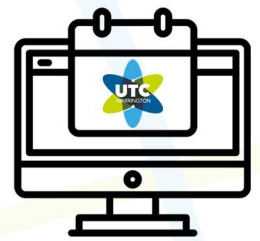

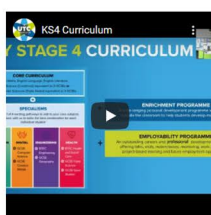
Welcome to our UTC Warrington virtual event!

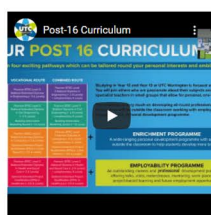
